Pierpaolo Levi

Born in Trieste, Pierpaolo Levi studied with *Nives Caetani Buzzai*. He achieved his doctorate at the Conservatorio C. Monteverdi of Bolzano and afterwards took courses with eminent musicians such as N. Montanari, R. Caporali and G. Cziffra. In 1982 the Accademia Mozartiana of Bologna conferred on him the title of "Pianista".

After winning the First prize in the 1991 Rendano Competition in Rome, he has regularly performed for many Italian and foreign musical associations and institutions. On several occasions he performed in France, in Croatia and in Italy, where some recitals were recorded by the National TV Broadcasting Company. During a concert tour in Great Britain, one of his recitals, with music by F.Chopin and F.Liszt, was live recorded.

He is often invited as member of jury international and Italian piano Competitions. Pierpaolo Levi was invited to be one of the juries of the 8th Nat Studio Piano Competition in 2006. Pierpaolo Levi's repertoire ranges from Bach to contemporary composers (including, among many others, L.Nono, P.Boulez, K.H. Stockhausen, M.Kagel and S. Sciarrino) and also the complete Liszt Hungarian rhapsodies and the complete Chopin Studies, which he performed at the Chopin Festival in Paris. A Program entirely devoted to Mauricio Kagel was highly appreciated by the composer.
